Subject: SISHU SAATHI scheme for Cardiac surgeries

The state has launched the SISHU-SAATHI scheme for Cardiac surgeries. The beneficiaries are all children 0-18 years of age.

Under these circumstances, the Dy. CMOH III of the district/DFWO (for Kolkata) is the Nodal Officer. The children screened and referred by the mobile health team will be lined up by the district for availing the scheme.

Moreover, the children screened with congenital heart diseases/rheumatic heart diseases, requiring surgical interventions, screened at Government health facilities and diagnosed at district hospital/medical college would also be eligible for lining up for the benefit of the scheme and would be lined up for the same by the Nodal Officer of the district/ In charge Early Intervention Centre IPGMER/facility based RBSK Nodal Officer as the case may be.

Referrals to the identified tertiary hospitals would be routed through and coordinated by the state nodal officer-AH until further orders. The list of Hospitals included in SISHU-SAATHI Scheme is as follows
