ACADEMIC ACTIVITY

- CDE Programme was organized in the department in the month of November, 2015. The topic of discussion was on "Role of Anti-Inflammatory Effects of Trypsin-Chymotrypsin Combination in day to day Dental/Oral Surgery Procedure."
- Another CDE Programme was organized in December, 2015. The topic of discussion was: "Role of Metronidazol as topical antiseptic in soft tissue infection of oral cavity."
- Chair-side discussions on special cases of academic interest i.e. management of chronic oral mucosal lesions; Dental management of severe medically compromised patients; Pre-operative management of oral malignant condition to improve the oral hygiene prior to definitive treatment etc; are being taken regularly.
- To promote academic interest amongst the house-surgeons, they are being encouraged for clinical case presentations of special interest regularly on Saturdays.

This is one of the few departments in this premiere Post Graduate Institute where PG course has not been introduced. We urge the administration to pursue the previous commitment towards introduction of MDS courses in this elite institute.

SERVICE INFORMATION

OPD location

Annexed to Emergency building 1st floor adjacent to Dept. of Radiology & Suraksha clinic. The dental dept requires a larger area beyond the radiation zone as well as out of contaminated environment of the hospitalised patients of NCB (New Casualty Block) Ward blocking the entrance of the department.

Minor oral surgical procedures performed under local anaesthesia

- Surgical removal of impacted third molars (Wisdom tooth)
- Surgical removal of impacted canines
- Removal of periapical lesions.
- Repair of dent alveolar fractures and favourable fractures under L.A and inter-maxillary fixations
- Surgical excisions of oral soft tissue growth (non-malignant)
- Incisional and excisional biopsy
- Enucleation and marsupialisation of benign cysts and tumours of jaws
- Intra-oral and extra-oral incisions and drainage of acute orodental infections
- All types of tooth extractions(intra-alveolar and trans-alveolar) including retained and broken roots
- Endodontic surgeries and periodontal surgeries under LA.

Other procedures performed in the department

- Anterior tooth endodontic treatment (RCT)
- Posterior tooth endodontic treatment (RCT)
- Supra-gingival and sub-gingival calculus removal & management of gum-bleeding
- Selective treatment for mal-aligned and mal-posed teeth (orthodontics)
- Management of different oral mucosal lesions
- Selective grinding / coronoplasty
- Treatment of soft-tissue ulcers of benign nature
- Pre-surgical therapeutic measures in case of kidney transplantation, eye surgery, oral malignancy or cardiac surgery
- Primary level orthodontic treatment
- Restorative services - tooth colored and non-tooth colored restoration of decayed teeth
- Pulp capping therapy

Inter-disciplinary referrals are well attended with proper care & attention. Indoor patients with oral & maxillofacial injury referred from Dept. of Plastic Surgery and ENT are being evaluated regularly & opinions are also reciprocated.
