Minor oral surgical procedure performed under local anesthesia

- Surgical removal of impacted third molars
- Surgical removal of impacted canines.
- Removal of periapical lesions.
- Repair of dentoalveolar fractures and fractures of mandible [angle and parasymphysis], maxilla, orbital rim zygomatic complex under local anesthesia and intermaxillary fixation as well as mini bone plate fixation by extra oral incision under local anesthesia.
- Surgical excision of oral soft tissue growth.
- Surgical removal intrabony lesion.
- Incisional and excisional biopsy.
- Arthrocentesis of temporomandibular joint.
- Enucleation and marsupialization of benign cysts and tumors of the jaw.
- Intraoral and extraoral incisions and drainage of acute orodental infection.
- All types of tooth extractions including the retained roots and broken roots.
- Endodontic surgeries and periodontal surgeries under local anesthesia.

Other procedures performed in the department

- Anterior teeth endodontic treatment [RCT]
- Posterior teeth endodontic treatment [RCT]
- Pulp capping therapy.
- Treatment of soft tissue ulcers of benign nature.
- Management of different oral mucosal lesions.
- Selective grinding / coronoplasty
- Analysis of orthodontic malocclusion with comprehensive treatment planning.
- Interdisciplinary referral from both outdoor and indoor department of IPGMER & SSKM and Sambhunath Pandit Hospital Annex-2 are all attended with utmost care and attention.
- Patient referrals from department of nephrology, CTVS, radiotherapy, ophthalmology, orthopedics are regularly examined and treated pre-surgically for necessary dental fitness.
