Report of the ART Center

ART or Anti-retroviral therapy centres are OPD based service providers for PLHIV (People living with HIV). Patients who are tested positive at Integrated Counseling Testing Centre (ICTC) are referred to ART centres for care, support and treatment.

SSKM ARTC is functional since 18/12/2012. All ART centres of WEST BENGAL are working under supervision of WBSAPCS, CST Division and funded by NACO.

ART Centre is functional under Medicine Department, of SSKM& IPGMER Hospital.

Work responsibilities

1. Enrollment of patients who are tested positive at integrated counseling testing centre (ICTC)
2. Ensuring ART treatment for the patients after necessary investigations and proper counseling.
3. Regular monitoring of patients for opportunistic infection and drug related side effects, every visit counseling and follow up of the patients are done at ART centre, SSKM.
4. B diagnosis and initiation of anti-tubercular therapy (ATD) of ICTC reactive patients are done at ARTC, SSKM.
5. Procuring ART drug from NACO, Drug stock maintenance and regular reporting of various data to WBSAPCS and NACO are done here.
6. Inter-departmental referral and initiating ART for admitted patients are done here.
7. Training of health care workers regarding HIV and Universal Precaution are included in the work responsibilities of ART Centers.
8. Advising and prescribing PEP (Post Exposure Prophylaxis) for health care workers and spouse/partner of a known positive patients are among ART centre's responsibilities. PEP is issued for emergency use to ICU, Labour ward, Emergency, Emergency OT, Trauma from ART Centre, SSKM.
9. Every month co-ordination meeting is conducted involving all ICTC, TB unit, CSC at ART centre, SSKM.
10. Core-committee meeting involving all the departments is done at ART centre yearly once.
11. CD4 testing, viral load testing and Hep B, Hep C testing done at ART centre, SSKM.
12. Spouse/Partner-child testing for ICTC and tracking of MIS or lost to follow up patients are done at SSKM ARTC with the help of CSC. ART centre functions as per NACO guideline and protocol. Counselling plays a major role in ART services. As SSKM & IPGMER is a tertiary hospital, our ART centre gets patient from various districts of West Bengal and different states.
13. Providing IPT to IC reactive patients and providing TPT to eligible negative relatives of seropositive patients.

14. Providing PEP to health care workers for occupation related hazards. In case of any exposure of health workers to blood, amniotic fluid , CSF, pleural fluid or infective body fluid of seropositive individual, PEP is advised from ARTC. PEP is also kept at Labour Room, Trauma Care, Emergency, Emergency(NER) OT, ICCU for immediate use.

On average daily footfall at our ART centre 50-80 patients. Approximately 450-500 TB cases have been treated at ART centre, SSKM along with the collaboration with NTEP.
