NOTICE

For candidates admitted to various DM-MCh courses (2025-28 session) in IPGME&R, Kolkata, through NEET-SS counseling 1st round and yet to join because of upgradation option YES given in 1st round

Candidates who have taken admission to various DM-MCh courses in IPGME&R, Kolkata, through NEET-SS counseling 1st round and who were waiting to join because they have given upgradation option as YES in the first round are hereby informed that they can **join their respective departments from July 17, 2026 (Friday) onwards.**

This notice is being issued in the light of the changed circumstances following MCC, GoI, Notice Ref.U-12021/01/2026-MED dated 06.07.2026.

Following points are to be noted:

1. For joining, candidates must fill up the Medical Course joining form, available from the Dean Office, in triplicate. This must be forwarded by HOD of concerned department and countersigned by the Dean for completion.
2. Four identical color passport photos (recent) are required at the time of joining.
3. Candidates in service with the West Bengal Government or any other state government / central government / autonomous public sector organization / municipal corporation, etc., must come with appropriate release orders.
4. Candidates will have to submit a written undertaking at the time of joining that they will abide by the decisions of the state government regarding payment of stipend and course tenure. Also, if they are upgraded and leave IPGME&R in 2nd or subsequent rounds of counseling they will be eligible for refund of only the caution money component and not the nominal tuition fees paid at the time of admission.
5. Candidates who wish to avail hostel accommodation (not available ordinarily to in-service candidates) must fill in the hostel application form at the time of joining and inform the department about this. If departments are able to allot seats, this will be ratified by the Hostel Committee in consultation with the departments concerned. If departments are unable to allot seats, then Hostel Committee will try to allot seats in conformity with its standard operating procedure. Note that it may take a few weeks to allot hostel seats and seats MAY NOT be allotted to all applicants.

If any further notices are issued by MCC, GoI, that may materially affect the joining process the institute will abide by that and act accordingly.
