The following candidates are being empaneled and may be called to join if the selected candidates fail to join by the stipulated time. The panel is provisional (subject to acceptance by the University) and will remain valid till 31.07.2021.

Selected candidates are being informed that date of commencement of the course is 01.07.2021 and the tenure is till 30.06.2022. Therefore, admission formalities need to be completed prior to commencement of course.

Candidates who are in service (faculty position / bond posting) are advised to apply for necessary approval for joining the course from their employing authority without delay. Admission will not be allowed without such approval.

After joining, selected candidates will be enrolled in the course full time and will:

- Draw stipend at par with 3rd year MD/MS trainees. However, those who are in government service and joining the course under TR / special leave will draw their salary from their place of posting and will not be eligible for stipend from the institute.
- Pay admission fee of Rs. 18,050/- (Rupees Eighteen thousand and fifty) only at the time of admission, same as with other postdoctoral trainees, of which Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand) only will be refundable security deposit. However, security deposit will be forfeited if the course is discontinued by the candidate prematurely.
- Pay Tuition fees at the rate of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only per month, again at par with other postdoctoral trainees.
- Not be provided hostel facility at present.
- Not be involved in private practice of any kind.
