Notice for fresh MBBS students admitted in IPGME&R, Kolkata for the 2023-28 academic session

This is to inform all newly admitted MBBS students that their classes will commence on and from Monday, September 4, 2023 (04.09.2023).

The following are to be noted:

- The college has no prescribed uniform for MBBS students. However, they are expected to be in decent formal attire in class.
- Please take your seats between 10:30 to 10:45 AM in Lecture Theater 7 (LT-7) in the top floor of UCM Building.
- Welcome and introductory addresses by Director, Dean of Student Affairs, Medical Superintendent cum Vice Principal (MSVP) and various departmental heads will take up the first half of the day. After lunch break distribution of hostel seats will take place.
- Guardians are NOT to accompany students to class.
- Full-fledged classes will start from 07.09.2023.
- Ragging is a punishable offence. All students must strictly abide by antiragging regulations.

Hostel applicants to note:

- As informed by Hostel Committee till date, approximately 80 seats for male students and 30 seats for female students will be made available for the fresh First MBBS batch initially. Boys' and girls' accommodations are separate.
- Allotment will be done on the basis of domicile, distance of permanent address from the location of college, and physical disability, if any, only. Hostel committee's decision will be final in this regard. Individual requests to consider or reconsider cannot be entertained. Since the admission process is still ongoing, the list will be finalized after 01.09.2023 from among eligible candidates.
- Every effort will be made to distribute hostel seats on the first day itself to selected candidates.
- Needless to say, hostelites will have to abide by all rules and regulations of the hostel. No parent, sibling, relatives, friends, etc. can share hostel seat with a student, even for a day.
- First year students will be accommodated in dormitory style rooms. Bed, mattress, study desk will be provided. Personal use items (e.g. bedsheets, pillows, mosquito nets, toiletries, buckets, etc.) will have to be arranged by the students themselves.
- Substance abuse in any form (smoking, drinking, vaping) is prohibited in hostel and college premises.
- Cash and other valuables, including mobile phones, tablets, laptops, smart watches, jewelry, etc., are the responsibility of the student concerned. College authority cannot accept responsibility for misplaced, lost or stolen items.
- Those eligible hostel applicants who cannot be accommodated due to lack of seats have to make suitable alternative arrangements so that they are able to attend classes timely. Depending upon the vacancy situation, as notified by Hostel Committee, a few more students may be accommodated in future.

We look forward to welcoming our new batch of bright and meritorious students.
